Oualifications:

The ideal candidate will be open to new educational programs and techniques, and have an interest in archaeology, architecture, immigration, and Jewish culture. The candidate must also fulfill the following requirements and responsibilities:

- Be actively engaged for three (3) hours of touring
- Participate in setup and takedown of materials
- Commit to a minimum of four weekday mornings per month
- Attend class meetings regularly
- Delight in working with students
- Be flexible and collaborative with other educators

New training classes begin in the summer and then on days throughout the fall and spring.
