HALF FEST DIRECTORS SHOWCASE

Screenings and conversations will shine a light on the Half Foundation's efforts to support women and minorities in Hollywood

LOS ANGELES, CA—During the weekend of August 26–27, the Skirball Cultural Center will host the first-ever Half Fest Directors Showcase. This free two-day event is presented in partnership with the Half Foundation—a new initiative to offer mentorships and jobs to women, people of color, and members of the LGBT community seeking employment in entertainment. Attendees will have the opportunity to watch short films by the first cohort of Half Foundation mentees, as well as attend Q&As and talks on how to succeed in Hollywood.

The Half Foundation was founded in 2016 by acclaimed TV writer-creator Ryan Murphy (*Glee, American Horror Story, American Crime Story, Feud: Bette and Joan*). Murphy himself has succeeded in staffing 60% of his shows with women and minority directors. In its first year, his Half Foundation has mentored nearly thirty emerging directors from these underrepresented groups.

"I'm pleased that the public will have a chance to view the work of rising talented directors," remarked Murphy. "The Half directing mentees range from college students to professionals and have created worthy short films."

"The work of advancing diversity and equity in American life is a shared responsibility that benefits us all," commented Andrew Horwitz, Skirball Vice President and Director of Programs. "As an institution dedicated to welcome and inclusion, the Skirball is proud to partner with the Half Foundation in its efforts to nurture the talents of women and minorities in Hollywood, as well as diversify the stories that enter our homes and our lives."

In addition to the afternoon screenings, Saturday's showcase will conclude with a panel discussion on the range of director programs around town, with tips on how applicants can stand stand out among their peers. Panelists include industry executives from Half, Fox, NBC, CBS, and Warner Bros. Following Sunday's afternoon screenings, attendees can hear from accomplished directors Jennifer Lynch and Nelson Cragg.
